Module 1

1. Identify and select digital resources that meet specific teaching and learning aims,
2. Analyse and evaluate digital resources adopting criteria that reflect quality and pedagogical values,
3. Learn and use strategies to process the available information and digital resources, including copyright.

Module 2

1. Apply design principles and processes to create digital resources to meet teaching and learning aims,
2. Modify and adapt existing digital resources, considering copyright and distribution licences to meet teaching and learning needs.

Module 3

1. Understand and implement basic digital security measures such as encryption, access control, and secure file storage.
2. Assess and optimise your digital storage solutions to ensure safety and accessibility.
3. Develop strategies for responsible use and sharing of digital resources to maintain privacy and integrity.

Module 4

1. Discuss the benefits & challenges of sharing educational resources
2. Understand the fundamentals of intellectual property and copyright licenses in digital content sharing.
3. Evaluate the significance of copyright licenses and Open Educational Resources in promoting responsible sharing and innovation in education.
4. Analyse the operation of copyright licenses and their impact on a creator's rights and content sharing practices.
5. Apply knowledge of ethical considerations and various sharing channels to effectively select and distribute teaching materials.
